Two areas behind the glass in the back wall are available to families with children who need a little extra attention during Mass.

Assisted hearing devices are available. Please ask an Usher if you need one.

Two immune-suppressed rooms are available in the back of the church for anyone whose health requires a more isolated environment for Mass.

If you have difficulty approaching the altar for Holy Communion, please tell an Usher and **Communion will be brought to you.**

If you would like to have a Mass offered for someone, or if there is someone you think we should pray for during the Mass intentions, please call the church office.

Our book of prayer intentions is located by the blessing bowl in the main entrance of the church. You may write your prayers and concerns and they will be brought to the altar during Mass.

The Adoration Chapel is available 24 hours a day! Visit the church office to get a key for after-hours access to the chapel.
